

Vendors Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. How can I be a vendor at Fiesta on the Hill?** Vendor forms are available to download from this website. Fill out and return to address listed with your check payable to BHNC.
- 2. What are the vendor prices at Fiesta on the Hill?** Vendor prices are listed on the vendor application.
- 3. Where is my booth/table space located?** Your participant packet, with your location and set up information, will be mailed to you 20 days before the event.
- 4. Can I reserve a corner space?** Yes, they are an additional \$35 and must be a separate check. If we are able to put you in a corner space, we will deposit your corner fee when we allocate your space. Please note: there are limited corner spaces available. Corner spaces are on a first come first served basis.
- 5. When can I set up?** Set up times and locations will be mailed to you with your participant packet 20 days before the event. You do not need to check in.
- 6. Can I bring my own booth or table?** Yes. We do not provide anything for you but the space, unless you have made other arrangements with us.
- 7. If I rent a booth from BHNC, how big is it?** The booth is 10x10 and will have a white canvas canopy and 4 white canvas half walls 3ft high.
- 8. I plan to sell art work and handicrafts but it is not my own, can I qualify for the Artist rate?** No, only original artists selling their own work can qualify for the artist rate. If your merchandise is not original or not your own, you will be asked to pay the full merchant rate.
- 9. I am selling home made food item, do I need a health permit?** Yes. Please note on the application that you will be selling pre-packaged food and we will send you the health permit and we will invoice you \$100 for the fee. If you will be cooking onsite, you must apply as a Food Vendor and fill out both the health and fire permits. You can find that application on the website. Please note that the Departments of Health and Fire will be on site for inspection.
- 10. I want to be a food vendor – what are the costs involved?** The food vendor fee is \$550, plus \$250 for the health and fire permit fees. We provide you with a 10x10 space and a 10x10 cooking area. We do not provide the booth.
- 11. I am a food vendor, do I have to recycle my food garbage items?** Yes, this year all food vendors are required to recycle their food waste.
